With a focus on capturing natural light from every angle, The Grove custom build by Trendsetter Homes is filled with bright ideas to maximise its northern orientation.

With an abundance of floor-toceiling windows and subtle, soft details, the versatile spaces and sweeping living hub prioritise functionality in this Wembley home.

"The main intention of the home was to capture as much northern light as possible," Trendsetter Homes Managing Director Michael Agostino said.

Generous spacing on the ground

floor caters to family and guests across an open-plan kitchen, dining and living area.

"As the family love to cook and entertain, the kitchen has a large scullery, which is completely out of sight from the main dining and living space," Mr Agostino said.

"The kitchen was also cleverly located, so you can entertain guests while keeping an eye on the children in the playroom or in the backyard."

Mr Agostino said the alfresco was raised above the pool area, with dual access to the kids' games room and capacity for a lounge set in addition to an alfresco dining set.

"It transitions smoothly between inside and outside and has been created to a high specification but without being fussy or overdone," he said.

Upstairs, the master bedroom is of epic proportions, cloaked in organic materials and modern drapery.

"Attention to detail was given to the custom cabinetry in the master bedroom, the walk-in robe and the ensuite," Mr Agostino said. "It also has a large seamless corner window that overlooks the front garden."
